# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF Las Vegas, New Mexico, Community Foundation

The undersigned, acting as incorporators to form a non-profit corporation under the New Mexico Nonprofit Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation

Article I: Name

The name of the corporation shall be: Las Vegas, New Mexico, Community Foundation

Article II: Duration

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

#### Article III: Purpose

- The Foundation is organized exclusively to solicit and receive funds and other resources, to
  manage and invest said resources solely for the benefit of non-profit organizations in the greater
  Las Vegas area and to provide support for such organizations by awarding grants to assist in
  meeting the community goals of said organizations.
- 2. The Foundation shall be operated within the meaning of 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended, including, for such purposes, the make of distribution to organizations that also qualifies as Section 501 (c) (3) exempt organizations.
- The Foundation shall be a not-for-profit community based organization whose staff and board
  members have the capacity to develop policies and procedures to solicit, manage and disperse
  resources for the benefit of Las Vegas area non-profit organizations and the citizenry of the
  community.
- 4. Foundation efforts will be directed toward the creation and maintenance of financial resources to assist Las Vegas area non-profit organizations to fulfill their missions in areas of education, cultural and historic preservation and economic and community development and any other program areas of interest as determined by the Board of Directors.
- 5. All funds, whether income or principal, and whether acquired by gift or contribution or otherwise, shall be devoted to said purposes and for no other purpose, and to that end to take and hold by bequest, devise, gift, grant, purchase, lease, or otherwise any property, real, personal, tangible or intangible, or any undivided interest therein, without limitation as to amount of value: to convey, or otherwise dispose of any such property and to invest, reinvest, or deal with the principal or the income thereof in such manner, as in the judgment of the Board of Directions, will best promote the mission and goals of the Foundation without limitations, except such limitations, if any, as may be contained in the instrument under which such property is received, these Articles of Incorporation, the By-Laws or the or the corporation of any laws applicable thereto.

#### Article IV: Exempt Status

The Foundation is constituted so as to attract substantial resources from contributions, directly or indirectly from persons and institutions both within and without the Las Vegas area community within which it operates. The Foundation has not been formed for pecuniary profit or financial gain, and no part of the assets, income or profit of the Foundation is distributable to, or inures to the benefit of, its directors or officers, except to the extent permitted by law, including reimbursement of expenditures. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Foundation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to (a) a corporation exempt from federal income tax under 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

#### Article V: Membership

The Foundation will not have members.

#### Article VI: Board of Directors

The affairs of the Foundation shall be conducted by a Board of Directors of six to ten members; the exact number of members may vary from time to time in accordance with the provisions of the By-Laws. Except for the initial Board of Directors, whose names are set forth in these Articles of Incorporation, the Board of Directors shall be elected in the manner provided by the By-Laws. The Board of Directors may, from time to time and consistent with the provisions of the By-Laws, structure itself in such committees, with such responsibilities as may be assigned to them by the By-Laws.

#### VII: Initial Board of Directors of the Foundation

Provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the Foundation, except as provided in these articles of incorporation shall be determined and fixed by the By-Laws of the Foundation as adopted and amended from time to time by the Board of Directors.

### Article X: Disposition and Assets Upon Dissolution

Upon the termination or dissolution of the Foundation in any manner or for any reason, its assets, if any remaining after payment (or provision for payment) of the liabilities of the Foundation, shall be distributed only to one or more organizations having exclusively charitable, community or economic development and historical and preservation purposes, or only for exempt purposes as described in 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Laws).
